### DECLARATION OF ROTARIANS IN BUSINESS AND PROFESSION

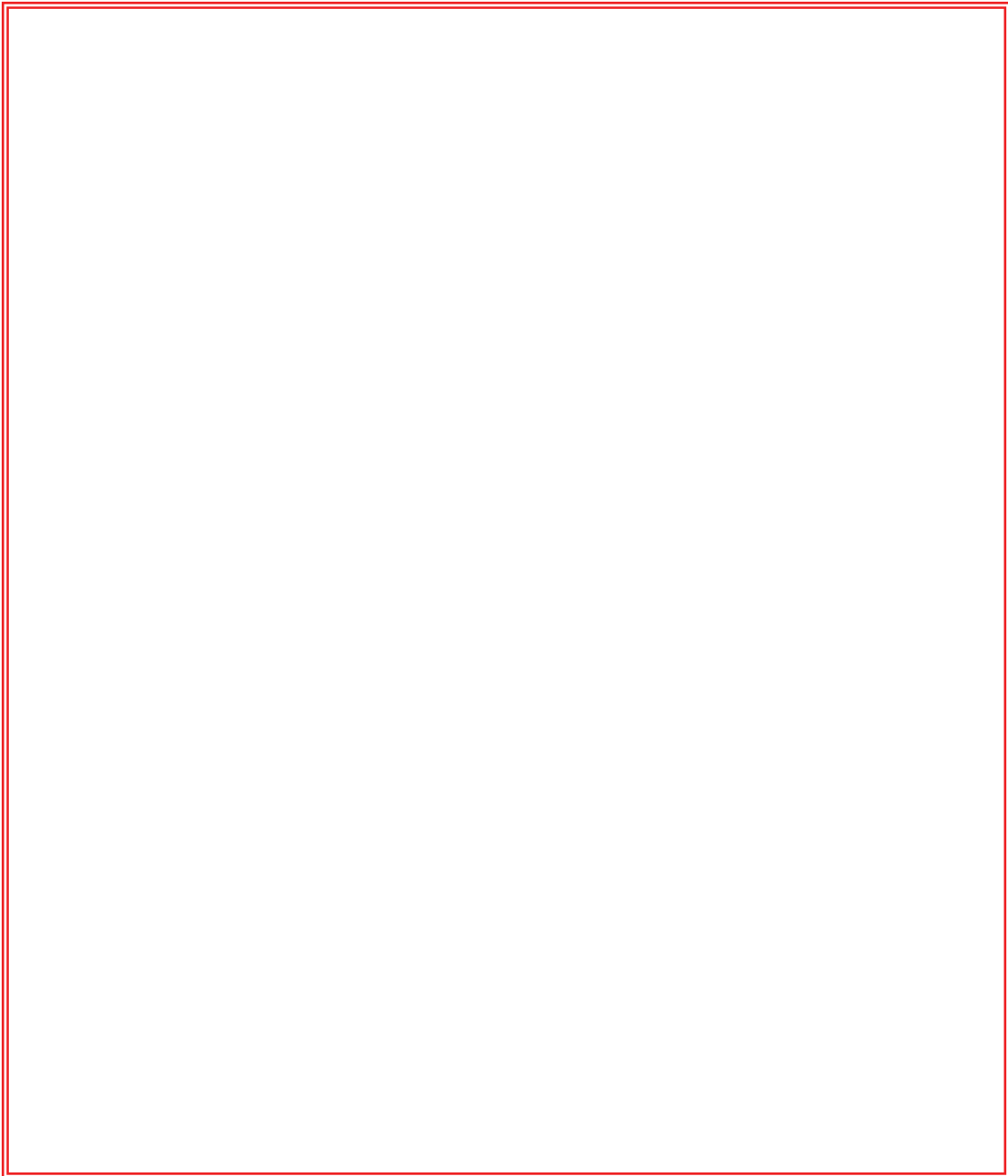
As a Rotarian engaged in business or profession, I am expected to:

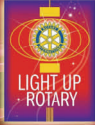
1. Consider my vocation to be another opportunity to serve;

Highlight local Interact or Rotaract club activities at our club meetings, invite Interactors or Rotaractors to speak about their ongoing projects, or launch a new project to benefit youth in our area.

### Promoting New Generations Service to Rotarians

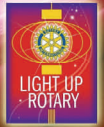
### New Generations and Membership

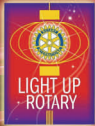

## ROTARY YOUTH EXCHANGE

Rotary Youth Exchange is Rotary's exchange program for youth and young adults. It allows students to spend up to a year living in a different country and learning a new culture. Students ages 15-19 can participate in a long-term exchange of up to one year, or they can choose a short-term exchange, which can last from several days to several weeks. New Generations Exchanges for young adults ages 18-25 can range from a few weeks to three months. Rotary clubs and districts sponsor exchange participants, who serve as ambassadors for their countries.

Your Rotary club can support Rotary Youth Exchange by

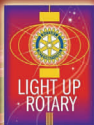
- Inviting an exchange student to give a presentation at a club meeting
- Coordinating with another club to host or sponsor a student
- Promoting the cultural and educational benefits of Youth Exchange to potential students and host families
- Arranging for a former or current Youth Exchange student to address the local parent-teacher association or a school assembly to personally recommend the program
- Contacting your district Youth Exchange chair or district governor for more information on getting involved

## ROTARY YOUTH LEADERSHIP AWARDS

Rotary Youth Leadership Awards is Rotary's leadership training program for young people. RYLA participants range from age 14 to 30, so most clubs and districts choose to focus on a specific age group, such as 14-18, 19-24, or 25-30. RYLA emphasizes leadership, citizenship, and personal growth. The program demonstrates Rotary's respect and concern for youth by providing an effective training experience for potential leaders, encouraging leadership of youth by youth, and publicly recognizing young people who serve their communities.

Your Rotary club can support RYLA by

- Asking school administrators and Interact club advisers to promote RYLA
- Inviting former RYLA participants to speak about their experience at a club meeting
- Budgeting to send local participants to the district RYLA event
- Recruiting young people with leadership potential in the community to attend a district RYLA
- Organizing RYLA reunions or follow-up events
- Contacting your district RYLA chair to find out how your club can participate

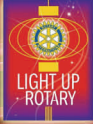

## Basics of Photography: Your Camera's Automatic and Assisted Settings

(continued from last week)

### Flash Modes

Your camera has a couple of different flash modes, and most of them you'll never need. Here's what they're called and what they do.



**Automatic flash** will only fire the flash when needed, which the camera determines by reading the available light on the subject. This generally happens when there isn't enough light anywhere in the frame or if the subject is backlit and appears dark to the camera as a result.



**Automatic flash with red eye reduction** works the same as the regular automatic flash mode but attempts to reduce the red eye effect that flashes often produce. If you're going to use an automatic flash mode, you might as well use this one.



**Forced/Fill-in flash** means the flash fires with every exposure regardless of whether or not the camera believes it's necessary. This is the mode you choose when you know you're always going to need the flash, or just think it's funny to cause temporary blindness to a bunch of people in rapid succession.

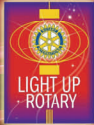


**Slow shutter flash (with red-eye reduction)** is what you want to use in a very low light situation, as the shutter speed will be reduced and the flash needs to offer a repeated bursts of light to compensate. If you're using an automatic mode, the camera will determine when this is necessary and do it automatically. If you know you're going to need a slow shutter flash, however, you can force it with this mode.



**No flash** is pretty obvious. It turns the flash off so it won't be used under any circumstances.

Fancier flashes will have additional modes and settings on the flash units themselves, so if you have a nice external flash be sure to experiment with everything it can do.
