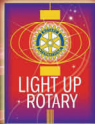

# GOLDEN PRESIDENT

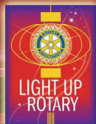

The most effective and least expensive way to reduce disease and save lives is easier than you think. Simply washing your hands with soap and water can do more to prevent diarrhea, death by malnutrition, and dehydration than any single vaccine or medical intervention, according to scientific studies.

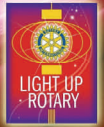
On 15 October, [Global Handwashing Day](#), millions of people in more than 100 countries will take part in activities promoting this practice. Rotary brings its own expertise and diverse perspectives to such efforts by providing access to clean water and sanitation.

Rotary members in Argentina and Georgia, USA, have been working together since 2009 on the Better Health Through Better Hygiene project. Clubs provide books and personal hygiene kits to kindergarten and first-grade students in the suburbs of Buenos Aires. They also supply teachers with posters and manuals to help them promote better hygiene, as well as equipping the schools with soap, hand sanitizer, and dispensers to encourage regular hand washing at school.

In the Dominican Republic, Rotary clubs launched an ambitious campaign to teach the importance of hand washing to schoolchildren. A live, one-hour program will be televised across the country on Global Handwashing Day. Public service announcements on the radio, on television, and in newspapers, funded by a Rotary Foundation grant, will also promote this health initiative.

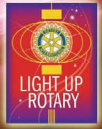

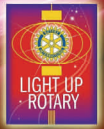

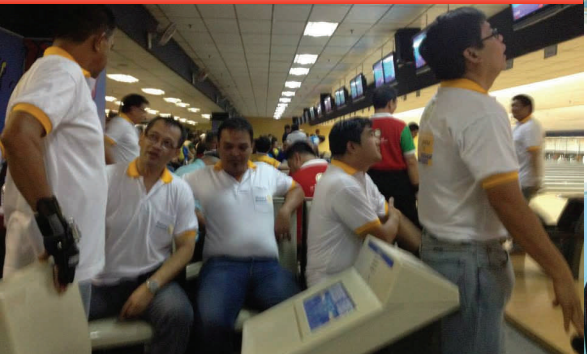

## The Concept of Vocational Service

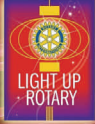

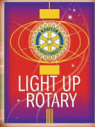

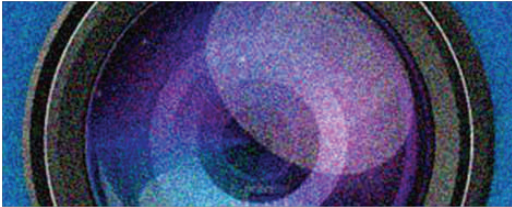

## Basics of Photography: Your Camera's Manual Settings

### ISO



ISO is the digital equivalent (or approximation) of film speed. If you remember buying film for a regular camera, you'd get 100 or 200 for outdoors and 400 or 800 for indoors. The faster the film speed the more sensitive it is to light. All of this still applies to digital photography, but it's called an ISO rating instead.

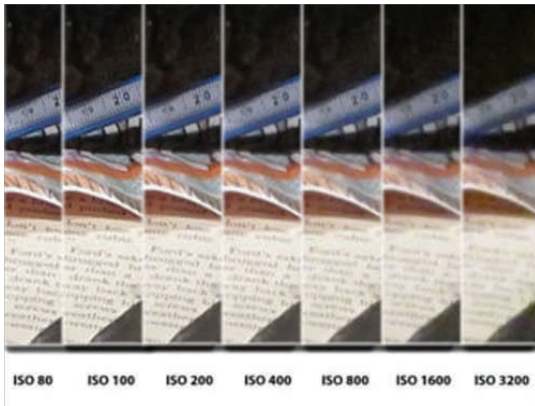
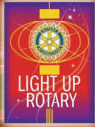

The advantage of a low ISO is that the light in a given exposure is more accurately represented. If you've seen photos at night, the lights often look like they're much brighter and bleeding into other areas of the photo. This is the result of a high ISO—a greater sensitivity to light. High ISOs are particularly useful for picking up more detail in a dark photograph without reducing the shutter speed or widening the aperture more than you want to, but it comes at a cost. In addition to lights being overly and unrealistically bright in your photos, high ISO settings are the biggest contributors to photographic noise. High-end

cameras will pick up less noise at higher ISOs than low-end cameras, but the rule is always the same: the higher you increase your ISO, the more noise you get.

Most cameras will set the ISO automatically, even in manual mode. Generally you can stick with the same ISO setting if your lighting situation doesn't change, so it's good to get used to setting it yourself. That said, sometimes lighting changes enough in dark, indoor settings that letting the camera set it for you automatically can be helpful—even when shooting manually.

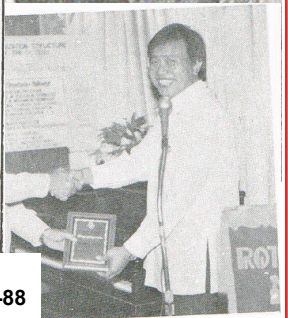
