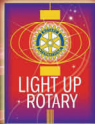

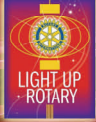

**Facebook** is diving deeper into the publishing industry by launching today 'Instant Articles' for its first media partners. **'Instant Articles'** is a publishing platform that allows you to read the news natively through Facebook, in a fast and direct way.

According to Facebook, articles will now load even **10 times faster** than the usual mobile web, leading to a clear and interactive environment that enhances the reading experience along with the display of visual content. As of now, Facebook launches 'Instant Articles' with content from The New York Times, National Geographic, BuzzFeed, NBC News, The Atlantic, The Guardian, BBC News, Spiegel Online, Bild.



Facebook is hoping to **take publishing apps to the next level**, by introducing a new interactive platform that offers creative tools that turn each story into a whole new experience, with autoplay video, interactive maps, or even the author's voice through audio captions!

## What does this mean for publishers?

Although there is an initial fear on whether this would really benefit publishers that lose their web traffic, it actually offers them new opportunities to promote their content and reach a bigger audience.

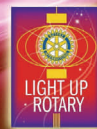

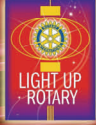

To give the district governor-elect and incoming assistant governors and district committees the opportunity to motivate club leadership teams and build their working relationship

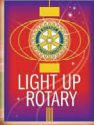

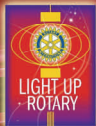

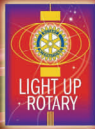
## 77 photography techniques, tips and tricks for taking pictures of anything



### **Landscape photography technique 11: minimalist landscapes**

Usually black and white, often square and frequently realised with the help of Neutral Density filters, minimalist landscape photographs are more about what you leave out than what you leave in.

Telephoto zooms will help you to frame interesting details that would make for a great minimalist landscape. Look for single trees, lone clouds and isolated rocks. Fog, snow and featureless skies will provide a suitable blank canvas for this type of picture too.
